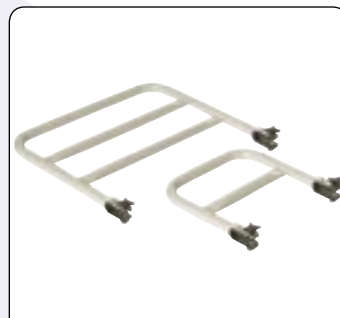
### Safe support in bed

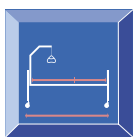
**Britt III** side rail offers a modern style to compliment the beech finish bed ends and helps complete the *Etude® Classic – Extra Low's* natural look.
